Cracking the HEDIS Mystery

Initiation and engagement of alcohol and other drug dependence treatment

Measure	Description
(IET)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Initiation of AOD Treatment. The percentage of members who initiate treatment through an inpatient AOD admission, outpatient visit, intensive outpatient encounter or partial hospitalization within 14 days of the diagnosis. • Engagement of AOD Treatment. The percentage of members who initiated treatment and who had two or more additional services with a diagnosis of AOD within 30 days of the initiation visit.
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a patient has an AOD dependence diagnosis, consider immediate referral to a behavioral health provider (BHP) to start treatment within 14 days of diagnosis. • If you choose not to refer the patient to a BHP, schedule a visit at your practice within 14 days of the AOD dependence diagnosis date to initiate AOD dependence treatment for the patient.
