<p>If we determine that you owe a late enrollment penalty (or if you currently have a late enrollment penalty), we need to know how you would prefer to pay it. You can pay by mail or credit card each month or quarterly. You can also choose to pay your late enrollment penalty by automatic deduction from your Social Security or Railroad Retirement Board (RRB) benefit check each month. If you are assessed a Part D-Income-related Monthly Adjustment Amount, you will be notified by the Social Security Administration. You will be responsible for paying this extra amount in addition to your plan premium. You will either have the amount withheld from your Social Security benefit check or be billed directly by Medicare or the RRB. DO NOT pay PHP the Part D-IRMAA.</p> <p>People with limited incomes may qualify for Extra Help to pay for their prescription drug costs. If eligible, Medicare could pay for 75% or more of your drug costs including monthly prescription drug premiums, annual deductibles, and co-insurance. Additionally, those who qualify will not be subject to the coverage gap or a late enrollment penalty. Many people are eligible for these savings and don't even know it. If you currently have health coverage from an employer or union, joining PHP could affect your employer or union health benefits. By completing this enrollment application, I agree to the following:

PHP is a Medicare Advantage plan and has a contract with the Federal government. I will need to keep my Medicare Parts A and B. I can be in only one Medicare Advantage plan at a time, and I understand that my enrollment in this plan will automatically end my enrollment in another Medicare health plan or prescription drug plan. It is my responsibility to inform you of any prescription drug coverage that I have or may get in the future. Enrollment in this plan is generally for the entire year. Once I enroll, I may leave this plan or make changes only at certain times of the year when an enrollment period is available (Example: October 15 – December 7 of every year), or under certain special circumstances.

PHP serves a specific service area. If I move out of the area that PHP serves, I need to notify the plan so I can disenroll and find a new plan in my new area. Once I am a member of PHP, I have the right to appeal plan decisions about payment or services if I disagree. I will read the Evidence of Coverage document from PHP when I get it to know which rules I must follow in order to get coverage with this Medicare Advantage plan. I understand that people with Medicare aren't usually covered under Medicare while out of the country except for limited coverage near the U.S. border.

I understand that beginning on the date PHP coverage begins, I must get all of my health care from PHP, except for emergency or urgently needed services or out-of-area dialysis services. Services authorized by PHP and other services contained in my PHP Evidence of Coverage document (also known as a member contract or subscriber agreement) will be covered. Without authorization, **NEITHER MEDICARE NOR PHP WILL PAY FOR THE SERVICES.**

I understand that if I am getting assistance from a sales agent, broker, or other individual employed by or contracted with PHP, he/she may be paid based on my enrollment in PHP.
