Zika New Recommendation for all pregnant women based on Zika outbreak in South Florida

Per CDC guidelines all pregnant women must be tested for the Zika virus.

Please educate all pregnant members re:

- Pregnant women should use condoms throughout the entire pregnancy to ensure protection from possible infection from partners.
- All pregnant women should take precautions to protect themselves from mosquito bites, including using DEET based insect repellent and staying away from areas of high concern. i.e. standing water, etc.
- Deet based insect repellent is now part of the OTC benefit for all Medicaid members.
