Medicare Annual Wellness Visits – UPDATE

PHP's Participating Primary Care Providers are encouraged to schedule and perform the Annual Wellness Visit with their assigned PHP Plan Members during every calendar year.

PHP feels this will be beneficial to Plan Members as earlier assessment of chronic conditions will result in better healthcare outcomes. It is under Medicare Risk Adjustment guidelines that all the Chronic Conditions and HCC conditions be assessed and reported on office visit claims.

PHP reimburses for an Annual Wellness Visit at a higher rate than a routine visit when properly billed using **CPT Code G0402**, **G0438** and **G0439**, whichever is applicable.
