Controlling High Blood Pressure

Measure	Description
Controlling High Blood Pressure (CBP)	<p>Members 18-59 years of age whose BP was <139/89.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Members 60-85 with a diagnosis of diabetes whose BP was <139/89. Members 60-85 years of age without a diagnosis of diabetes whose BP is <149/89.

Documentation of the following:

- Dx Hypertension on or before June 30 of the measurement year (6/30/2015) OR Undated problem list w/ diagnosis of hypertension
- AND *Dated documentation of the Lowest Systolic and Diastolic reading, taken during the most recent visit

Hypertension = HTN, high BP, elevated BP, border HTN, intermittent HTN, history of HTN, HVD, hyperpiesia, or hyperpiesis

CPT II Coding:

- 3079F : Diastolic 80-89
- 3080F : Diastolic Greater Than/Equal To 90
- 3078F : Diastolic Less Than 80
- 3077F : Systolic Greater Than/Equal To 140
- 3074F : Systolic Less Than 140
- 3075F : Systolic Less Than 140
