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Purpose of This Bulletin

Effective June 26, 2026, pharmacies enrolled in Medi-Cal Rx may only dispense medications to Medi-Cal members when the prescribing provider is enrolled in Medi-Cal Fee-for-Service (FFS) using their Type 1 National Provider Identifier (NPI).

What this means for prescribers:

- You must be enrolled in Medi-Cal FFS under your Type 1 NPI.
- Prescriptions and prior authorizations (PAs) submitted by non-enrolled prescribers will not be processed on or after June 26, 2026.

Failure to enroll may result in denied prescriptions and delays in patient care.
